C O N F I D E N T I A LPulse of the Squadron

High point for September was V-J Day (September 2) which set the spirit of the month for the Squadron. Just as the rest of the world struggled to avoid swift and damaging reconversion, so the 413th emphasized gradual transition to peace. The greatest factors determining activity were still those influences exerted from outside the Squadron, yet clearly there was to be no sudden movement, swift exodus of personnel, nor sweeping change in activities.

Instead of one great coordinated effort, as there had been in wartime, there was a smattering of activities which presaged peacetime status. Among the smaller things indicative of peace were the happy end of censorship, the beginning of regular inspections, and even a parade complete with band. The major activities too had this peacetime shading as some high-point personnel began the trip back to the States, flying training was resumed, packing of "battle" equipment was begun, and an emphasis on competitive sports appeared. In these various things was a true cross-section of activities in this Squadron as the first month of peace came to a close.

Purely Personnel

Changes in personnel came gradually, but nevertheless rapidly enough to be felt before the monthly period ended. On September 1st there were 71 officers and 253 enlisted men assigned to the Squadron; by September 30th this number had been reduced to 59 officers and 250 enlisted men. Most of the losses were in a Stateside direction

(eight officers and four enlisted men); there were also three transfers, and two men went home on emergency leave.^{1.} Among Key personnel lost were the Operations Officer, Executive Officer, Adjutant, and the four Flight Leaders. These were principally men with previous overseas service and high point scores. Their loss was deeply felt, not only because of the positions they held, but also because they had done so much to make the Squadron what it was.

Replacement was made as follows: Operations Officer, Captain Daly; Executive Officer, Lt. Serfling; Adjutant, Lt. Hoyer; Flight Leaders, Captain Gess; Lieutenants: Stambaugh, Worden, Milner, Flint, and Richmond. Flights A-1, B-1, C-1, and D-1 were established to reduce the excessive number of personnel in each Flight. In addition, flying officers who wished to remain in the post-war Air Force were assigned as assistants to the various staff officers, so that they could gain experience in ground activities.^{2.}

Another officer promotion list came through on September 5th.^{3.} Consequently the Squadron now has a Captain Nacht, and First Lieutenants Dietrich, Kehee, McIntyre, and Wellman.

The Fighting 413th: Awards

All personnel of the 413th were awarded two battle stars during September. The first of these battle honors was awarded for

participation in the Eastern Mandates Campaign - that was for the two Truk raids made during July. The other award was for participation in the Air Offensive, Japan, during the month of August - the first three VLR missions to the Empire.⁴ This was the first general recognition of the Squadron's combat activities.

In the Air

Combat flying was definitely at an end. Early in the month four flights of aircraft participated in the air escort for General MOORE as he left Fighter Command on September 3rd. On the 12th an equal number of planes joined with all other squadrons on the Island to fly a show mission to Saipan and Guam. Bad weather forced all planes to abort and later forced cancellation of the mission.⁵

Shortly after this, a new training program was instituted. The purpose of this was twofold: to increase the flying time of each pilot, and to maintain combat skill at a high level. Average hours were increased from 12 to 16 per month, with a total of 792 hours logged for the squadron. With its emphasis on formation flying, link training, air-to-air gunnery, and strafing (6,576 rounds of ammunition were expended) the program reverted flying to the training stage fulfillment of the mission of peacetime preparedness.

One aircraft was destroyed on September 7th. The plane failed to become airborne on take-off and the pilot was forced to ground-loop in stopping. This reduced total aircraft assigned to 25.

On the Line

The Line, too, began to assume the atmosphere of peacetime activity. Six of the eight guns on each plane were removed and wing gunnery lines were painted on each aircraft in conformity with Seventh Fighter Command regulations. The inevitable difficulty with too dust and rain had not been ended by the peace. However, preventive covers made to cover air ducts and crew chief stand covers helped to prevent damage to aircraft from those factors.

Inspectors of various and assorted makes ran riot on the line during the month. On the 15th the Squadron conducted a showdown inspection of all equipment, the purpose being to discover shortages prior to any future movement. And almost anytime one might turn a corner and stumble over a Group or Fighter Command inspector.

All excess TO and E equipment was turned in to the issuing agencies by all sections on the Line. Thereafter each section started to pack equipment not needed for current operations. This was done in anticipation of a future movement, which was not imminent but rather expected within a few months.

C O N F I D E N T I A LJust Around: Activities

The activity which aroused the greatest interest was the preparation of a Squadron Yearbook. Modeled along college annual lines this would be a pictorial as well as journalistic representation of life in the Squadron since its activation. It was an ambitious undertaking, begun in August and near completion at the end of September. All work was voluntary and was carried on in off-duty hours, and enthusiasm was evident in the large number of men who volunteered work and ideas. About ninety percent of the squadron personnel subscribed to the Book.

Another interest-getter was the competitive sports program. All sections with enough personnel to do so formed softball and volleyball teams for tournament competition or for individual games. There was great emphasis during the month on the sports program. The Armament volley-ball team won the Iwo Island semi-finals, but lost in the finals, and the Officers team reached the semi-finals in that competition. In the 414th Group Field Day, September 22nd, Sergeant Parenti won the broadjump and Corporal Griffin won the basketball free-throw for this Squadron. For all running events Captain Nacht acted as starter, and Lieutenants Fredricksen, McIntyre, Russell, and Vetolate were judges. This had no bearing on the final score made by the 413th.

Perhaps the only men-about-town for the month were Lieutenants Allison and Burke who visited Tokyo and Yokohama (prior to the restriction of all men to the Island). They wangled some time off,

flew to Atsugi, and spent two days sight-seeing. They reported almost complete destruction of both the cities they visited, and observed that the Japanese people appeared completely beaten. The Japs smiled profusely and bowed constantly as Americans passed them. Most of them were dirty and ragged, and they ran for cover at the sound of an airplane. The pilots returned with few souvenirs, for Jap business was virtually non-existent. This was more evidence of the effectiveness of air power.

Summarily Speaking

The transition to peace was now well under way. With the resumption of numerous zone-of-interior type of inspections and institution of the new training program peacetime standards and training were being applied. The return of high-point personnel to the States had begun and could be expected to continue at a fairly uniform rate. For those who remained it was just a question of time.

It seemed likely that the time of movement from Iwo Jima was drawing close. The greatest question of all was still unanswered - determination of the final status of the Squadron had not been made. Again it was evident that all future activities would depend on decisions made outside of the Squadron.

For the individual battle-starred members of the 413th there were still two battles to fight: the battle of rumors (raging 24 hours a day) and the battle of transportation home. Of all the problems of an Army career, this last battle seemed most important.
